Great News! - our pool will be back open on Monday 17th April!

A welcome back message from our Pool Manager ...

Hello and welcome back to all our Members.

We are very grateful for your patience whilst we have completed the repair work that was necessary, following a fire, in November last year. We are pleased to inform you that we have taken this time to complete some much needed and anticipated refurbishment works to get us ready for our return. These refurbishments have meant that we are thankfully able to adjust the procedures for swimming at Imber Pool.

What will change -

The indoor changing rooms will now be reopened for all swimmers before and after swims and lessons. The cabins will now be used as office space, and this will be where our staff work from, and will no longer be open to the public.

The windows in the shallow end have been replaced. They now provide a clear view out to the grounds. We do ask that these are not used for spectating, to respect the privacy of those using the pool.

The pool hall has now increased in size. Members are asked to wait in this area prior to their swim and wait for the lifeguard to remove the barrier. This is to ensure the members in the previous pool session, get the full time.

A welcome desk is located at the old pool office. Lifeguards will meet you here and check membership cards for all persons swimming so please remember to bring these with you. Payments must be made before your swim.

Children must remain with parents in this area and wait for the barrier to be opened before entering the water.

What we will not be changing -

Members must only use the changing room appropriate to their gender identity. There will be no flexibility to this as we will be having sessions running back-to-back.

Changing rooms must not be used as waiting rooms. Whilst we have done our best to increase space in the changing rooms, there is still limited space when we are at full capacity.

Outdoor shoes must be removed before entering a changing room. All outdoor shoes must be left in the entrance hall **ONLY**. Anyone found to be wearing shoes anywhere in the pool area, will be asked to leave.

We will also remove any shoes found inside the changing rooms. We have worked hard on the renovation - mud and dirt brought in by outdoor shoes will cause damage that we cannot fix.

We hope that you are all as pleased with the repair and refurbishment work as we have been and look forward to uninterrupted pool use to the summer holidays. We are looking forward to welcoming everyone

back after the Easter holidays and we are all excited for the term ahead.
